Word Processing / Document Assembly	MS Word 2003. Also Adobe Acrobat Reader V5.0 or later (V7 included on CD) for NCIS Forms (although a version of Adobe Acrobat capable of Writing/Saving PDF Forms is recommended, e.g. Acrobat 7.0 Elements, Standard, Professional or 3D).	
Email	MS Outlook 2000 or higher or Outlook Express with valid Email account

Multi-User Environment	Can work on a peer-to-peer network or Server based environment. If Server based the server should be the same or better specification as the workstations.	
Network Cards	100Mb Intel, 3COM, D-Link or LinkSys network interface card recommended. 10Mb can be used in Workstations only (not Server). 100Mb or higher recommended for network hubs/switches. Network cards using Realtek RTL8139 chipset are NOT recommended (e.g. Realtek, Genius, TrendNET, Micronet, Edimax, Aopen, Accton, Alloy 1439, LanVision, Pancer, Zonet and several).	
Cabling	Category 5 network cabling recommended to maximise the performance of your network.	
Internet Connection	The Bank of England Consolidated Sanctions List check requires a fast ADSL Broadband connection.
